A workshop on *How to excel in Board Examination* was conducted by Mrs Saranya Krishnan for Grades X, XI and XII on 9th and 10th July 2020.

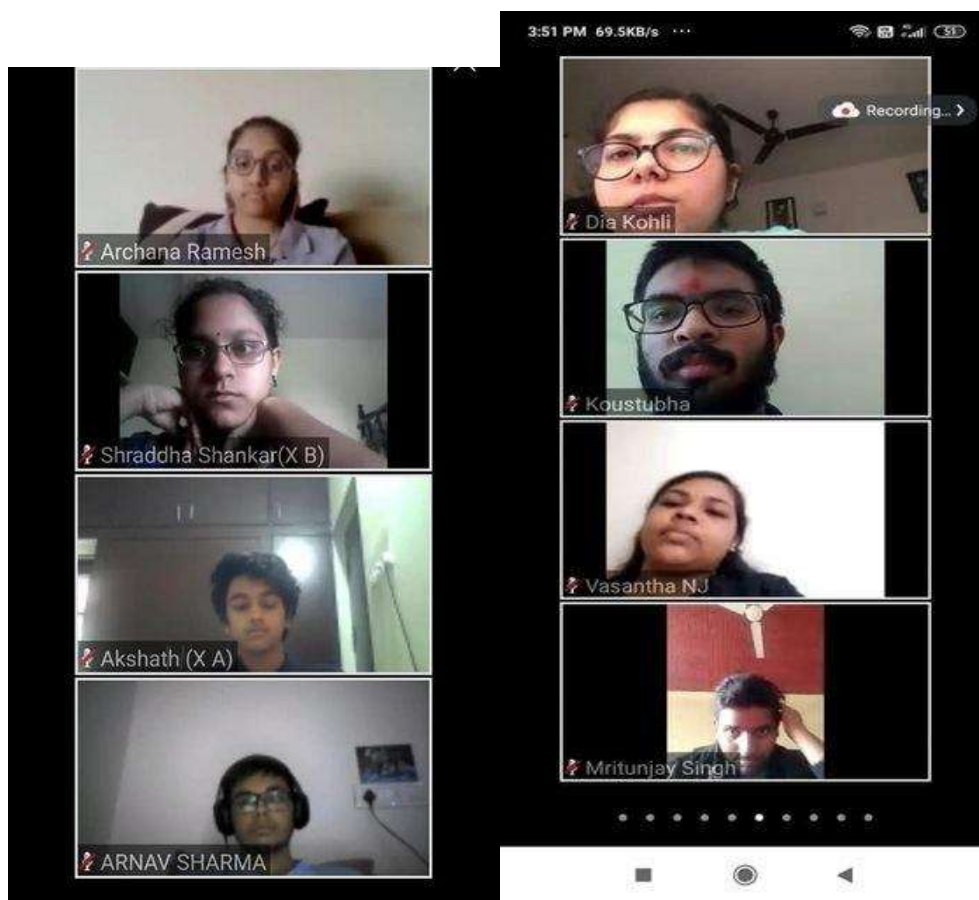
